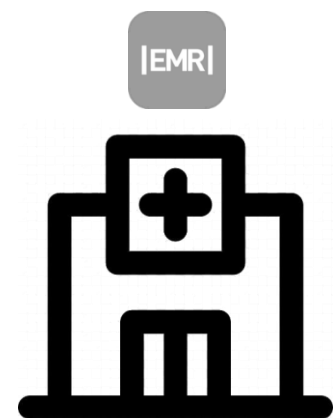
Safety Monitoring, Codes, NDC, Workflow & Contacts

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AZ IMMUNIZATION DATA/INVENTORY EXCHANGE

- CDC sends ADHS # of doses for AZ.
- ADHS divides by county population, gives allocation to Counties.
- County allocates doses to providers/partners by tier group or POD.
- ADHS links doses in ASIIS to provider.
- Providers accept doses in ASIIS.
- Doses shipped to location by CDC distributor.
- Doses administered by provider.
- Provider reports patient record to ASIIS and vaccine inventory adjusted.
- Provider bills health plan for admin fee.
- ADHS runs doses administered report sends to county to track allocation.
- ASIIS reports inventory to CDC.

AZ COVID-19 Vaccine Billing Policy

- In-network reimbursement for **flu and covid-19** vaccine from most health plans by [Executive Order](#) (Must be registered as an AHCCCS provider for Medicaid plans)
- AHCCCS has expanded list of qualified providers to include EMS, Dentists, Etc.
- Pharmacies bill Medicaid using Medical claims
- Offsite immunization clinics do not need additional state licensing [R9-10-103 4. & 5.](#)

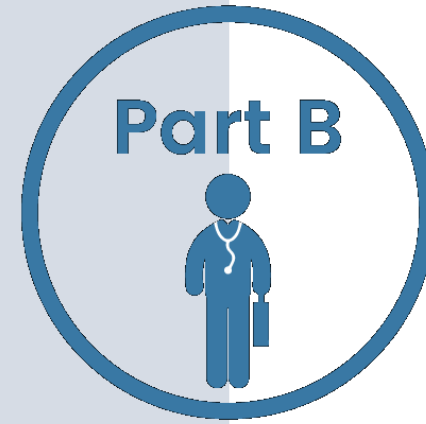

CMS COVID-19 Vaccine Part B Billing [Policy](#)

- **Current Medicare Providers:** If you're enrolled in Medicare under institutional or non-institutional provider types, you don't need to take any action to administer and bill the COVID-19 shot.
- **New Medicare Providers:** can enroll as a "Medicare mass immunizers" through an expedited 24-hour process. The ability to easily enroll as a mass immunizer is important for some pharmacies, schools, senior centers, and entities that may be non-traditional providers or otherwise not eligible for Medicare enrollment.
- **Mass Immunization Clinics:** Section 4 of the Form CMS-855, the supplier need **NOT** list each off-site location (e.g., county fair, shopping mall). It need only list its base of operation:
 - NIP and TIN of location of standing orders physician is used as the rendering provider
 - Place of service 60 is indicated in an offsite immunization setting

Groups that are signed up with Medicare that **DO NOT** have to Re-enroll as Mass Immunizers

Uninsured Patients and the Vaccine Admin Fee:

HRSA partnered with UHC's Optum Pay for uninsured covid testing, treatment claims. Vaccine administration fee was recently added.

All providers must [register](#) with Optum to submit uninsured claims for the administration fee only.

Temporary patient IDs need to be generated prior to claim submission and all claims should be final with no corrections. Will need a DL# or SS# for all uninsured patient claims [Claim requirements](#)

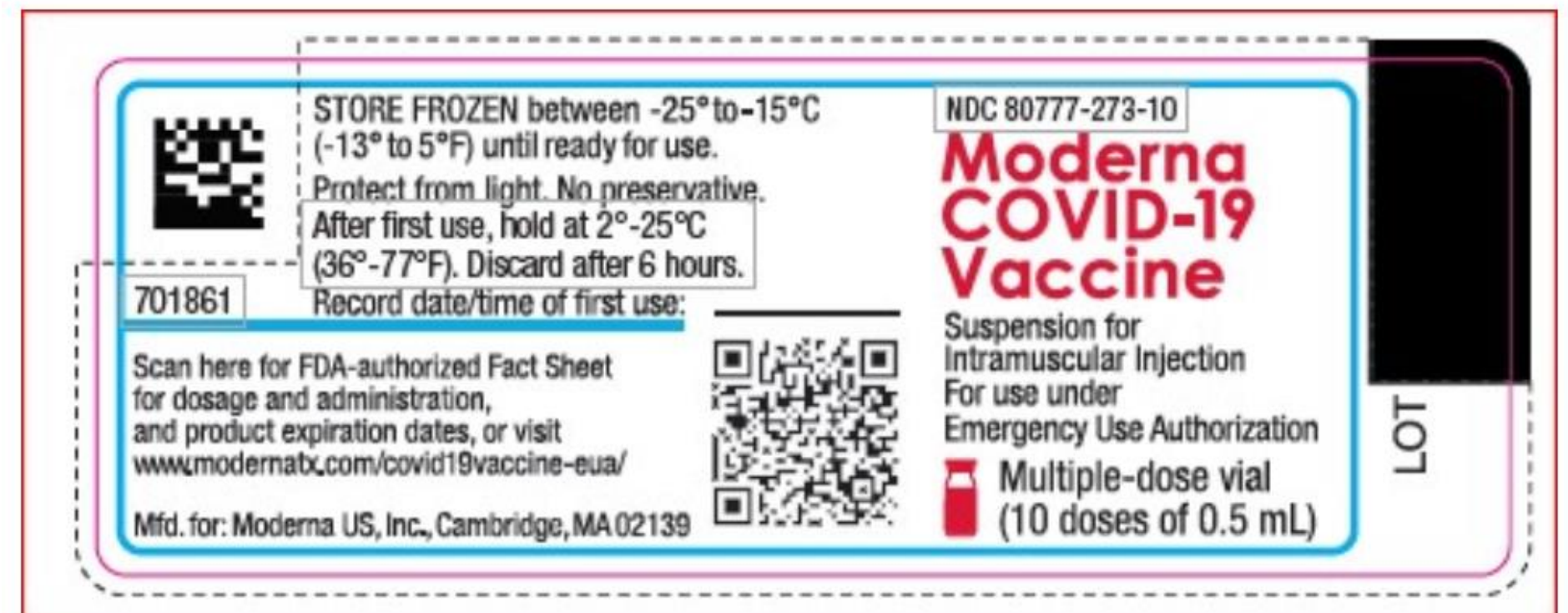

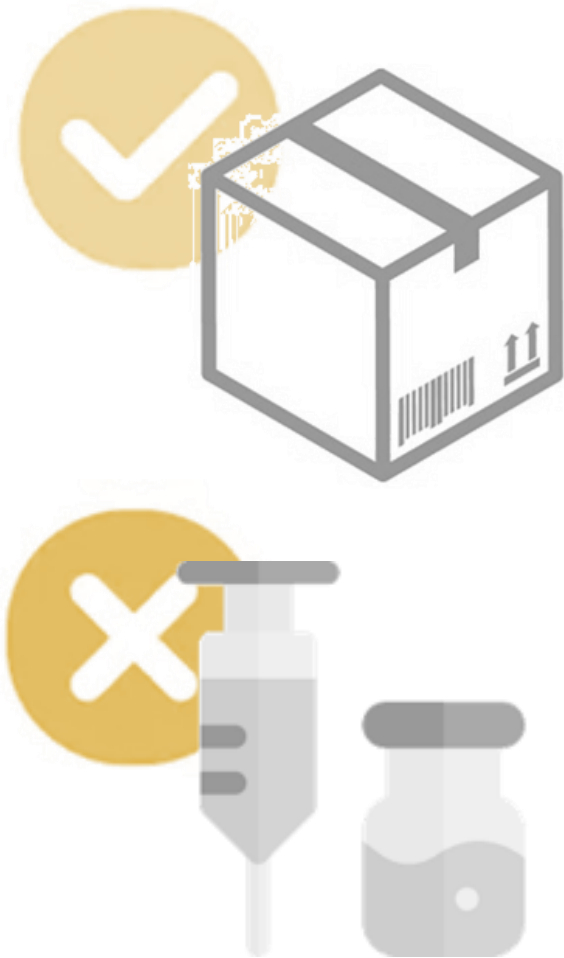

Potential Changes in Workflow

All Federal Vaccine:

1. Scan NCD from box not from vial or syringe for inventory reporting. (NDC Qualifier N4) 
2. Document in record as Federally supplied for inventory reconciliation and billing
3. Bill the admin fee to insurance or HRSA for uninsured. Vaccine is supplied at no cost.
4. Bill CMS Admin Fee Rate to all health plans public or private. \$16.94 & \$28.39
5. Bill under physician or global standing orders-
Place of Service code 60 - offsite immunization clinic

Pandemic Vaccine Change in Workflow

1. Use SL Modifier with vaccine - Amount \$.00 or \$.01
2. Admin code - Vaccine and Dose specific
0001A, 0002A, 0011A, 0012A
3. Admin fee – Dose specific \$16.94 or \$28.39. ALL plans private/Medicaid
4. Rendering provider is tied to Standing orders physician location
5. Place of Service is the offsite location
